Reduction of Bogies attached to Trains from Delhi to Kerala

401. SHRI JOY NADUKKARA: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any reduction of the number of bogies attached to the trains from Delhi to Kerala recently;

(b) if so, how much is the reduction for each train; and

(c) what steps Government have taken to remove the inconvenience of the passengers to Kerala caused by the

reduction in the number of bogies, especially in the coming Christmas and Sabarimala pilgrimage season?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SURESH KALMADI): (a) Yes Sir.

(b) Loads of 2625/2626 Kerala Express and 2617/2618 Mangala Express have been reduced by 3 and 1 Coach(es), respectively due to less traffic during lean season.

(c) To meet the extra rush during Christmas, Sabarimala season, etc., the

loads of these trains will be augmented from 15-12-95.

Demand for Double Line to Paradeep Port from Haridaspur

402. SHRI PRAVAT KUMAR SAMANTARAY: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is a constant public demand to have double line to Paradeep Port from Haridaspur to meet the demand of coal supply for southern grids;

(b) if so, whether survey has been conducted for the said railway line linking Paradeep Port to South Eastern Railway main line at Haridaspur; and

(c) if so, what is the expected financial return and what steps are contemplated to be undertaken for construction of this proposed railway line?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SURESH KALMADI): (a) to (c) Some suggestions have been received in the past., Doubling exists between Haridaspur and Nergundi and has been taken up between Raghunathpur and Rahama (28.40 Kms.). Doubling of the rest of the Section is expected to be taken up in the coming years as this section is included in the Master Plan for doublings.

Safety Gear for Tarapur Nuclear Plant

403. SHRI KRISHNA KUMAR BIRLA: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether the attention of Government has been drawn to the Press news-item captioned "US says no to safety gear for Tarapur" as reported in the "Pioneer" dated 12.8.1995;

(b) if so, whether the US agencies have declined to give spare parts for Tarapur Nuclear Power Plants; and

(c) if so, the reaction of Government on such comments?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (SHRI BHUVNESH CHATURVEDI): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) U.S. agencies had stopped supplying spare parts required for the Tarapur Atomic Power Station since long.

(c) In spite of U.S. agencies stopping supply of spares. Government has managed to run the Tarapur Atomic Power Station all along. Comprehensive capability has been built to develop most of the critical spares within the country.

श्री सत्य प्रकाश मालवीय:

क्या स्वास्थ्य और परिवार कल्याण मंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि:

(क) क्या अखिल भारतीय आयुर्विज्ञान संस्थान के नेत्र स्कंध की शल्यशालाओं को अक्टूबर, 1995 में बंद कर दिया गया था;

(ख) यदि हां, तो उसके क्या कारण हैं;

(ग) कार्य में असावधानी के कारण कितने रोगियों ने अपनी दृष्टिशक्ति खो दी; और

(घ) शल्यशालाओं के संक्रमणों से बचने के लिए क्या उपचारी कदम उठाए गए हैं?

स्वास्थ्य और परिवार कल्याण मंत्री (श्री ए० आर० अन्तुले): (क) केवल कुछ आपरेशन थियेटर और स्थानीय संवेदनाहरण पार्श्व अक्टूबर, 1995 में दो दिन बंद रहे थे।

(ख) ये थियेटर धूमन के प्रयोजन के लिए बंद रखे गये थे।

(ग) 11 मामलों जिनमें आपरेशन पूर्व संक्रमण विकसित हो गया था, में से 8 मामलों में संक्रमण को नियंत्रित कर लिया गया था। 3 मामलों में संक्रमण को नियंत्रित नहीं किया जा सका और नेत्र ज्योति वापस नहीं लाई जा सकी।
