

Implementation of decisions taken at International Women Conference at Beijing

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether any Plan of Action has been evolved to implement the decisions taken at the international Women Conference at Beijing to improve the lot of women in India; and

(b) if so, the phase wise details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPTT. OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (KUMARI VIMLA VERMA): (a) and (b) The Platform For Action including the Beijing Declaration has emerged as the consensus document adopted by the Fourth World Conference on Women with a commitment from Member Countries for the advancement of Women as laid down in Nairobi Forward Looking Strategies. As follow-up to the World Conference, India made specific commitments in respect of (i) formulation of a National Policy on Women (ii) increased investment of 6 per cent of GDP on education by 2000 AD; (iii) setting up of National Resource Centre for Women; (iv) setting up of Commissioner for Women's Rights; (v) universalisation of Mother and Child Care Programmes through Integrated Child Development Services Scheme and (vi) the implementation of Indira Mahila Yojana in selected blocks. A lot of steps have already been taken to implement these commitments.

Standard of education in Navyug Schools

(a) the details of Navyug Schools set up by Government in Delhi during the past two years;

(b) whether the standard of education in Navyug Schools have come down considerably;

(c) whether proper sports and extra curricular activities do not exist in such schools; and

(d) if so, the steps Government propose to take to improve the standard of such schools?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPTT. OF EDUCATION AND DEPTT. OF CULTURE (KUMARI SELJA): (a) to (d) According to information furnished by the New Delhi Municipal Council (who are running the Navyug Schools Educational Society), during the past two years, three Navyug Primary Schools, one each at Pataudi House, Tilak Marg and Mandir Marg, have been opened. They have further intimated that standard of education in Navyug Schools not come down and that all facilities for sports and extra curricular activities are available in Navyug Schools.
