(c) The present target is to attain full literacy *i.e.* sustainable threshold level of 75 percent literacy by 2005. According to National

Family Health Survey-2, (1998-99) released in November, 2000, literacy rate was 66.9% in 15.39 age group.

(d) Following steps have been taken:

- (i) NLM parameters have been revised and financial norms enhanced.
- (ii) Decentralization and delegation of financial and administrative powers to State Literacy Mission Authorities (SLMAs).
- (iii) The integrated Total Literacy Campaign and Post Literacy Programmes approach to achieve continuity, efficiency and convergence.
- (iv) Under Continuing Education Programme neo literates are provided opportunities for s!:l" development, income generating programmes and individual interest programmes. Centres also work for removal of residual illiteracy.
- (v) Jan Shikshan Sansthans to provide vocational and technical skills in both rural and urban areas.
