Setting up of Courts for Bhopal Gas Tragedy Cases

1957. DR. BAPU KALDATE: Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of courts pertaining to Bhopal Gas Tragedy set up so far and the number of courts likely to be set up during the current year;

(b) the amount of compensation paid so far by the courts;

(c) the amount allocated so far by the Supreme Court to Welfare Commissioner, Bhopal for providing compensation;

(d) the total amount including principal amount and interest deposited with the Supreme Court for this purpose; and

(e) the cause of dissension amongst surviving victims inspite of the compensation paid?

THE MINISTER OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI RAM LAKHAN SINGH YADAV: (a) to (c) The process of adjudication of compensation claims commenced in February, 1992 and funds for payment of compensation were made available by the Hon'ble Supreme Court to the Welfare Commissioner in October, 1992. 44 courts are adjudicating the compensation claims and 12 more courts are proposed to be set up. Of the amount of about Rs. 1,000 crores, transferred by the Supreme Court in the account of Welfare Commissioner, the Reserve Bank of India has allocated Rs. 662.82 crores upto 31.10.1995 and an amount of Rs. 573.84 crores has been utilised for payment of compensation.

Out of about 6 lakh compensation claims filed by the victims, 2,55 lakh claims have been adjudicated as on 7.11.1995 and a total amount of Rs. 710.53 crores awarded as compensation. The process of adjudication of cases which was slow in the initial stages, has since been speeded up and as many as 1.20 lakh cases out of 2.55 lakh cases so far disposed off, have been adjudicated since January, 1995.
