Concession to Sugarcane Growers

2816. SHRI SANATAN BISI: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government is proposing to provide any concession to the sugarcane growers; and

(b) if so, the details of concessions?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI ARVIND NETAM): (a) and (b) Under the on-going Centrally Sponsored scheme, "Sustainable Development of Sugarcane Based Cropping System", there is a provision to assist sugarcane growers for inputs like farm implements, equipment for drip irrigation and for conducting field demonstrations on sugarcane production technologies. Besides, the Statutory Minimum Price (SMP) of sugarcane payable by sugar factories has been raised to Rs. 42.50 per quintal for sugar season 1995-96 as against Rs. 39.10 per quintal in sugar season 1994-95 subject to basic recovery of 8.5% & Premium for increase in recovery above 8.5%.
