Newsitem regarding corruption by telephone linemen

1199. SHRI RAM RATAN RAM: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the newsitem which appeared in the 'Hindustan Times' dated 23rd July, 1995 entitled "The Men Behind the faulty Lines" dealing with the corruption of the telephone linemen; and

(b) what steps will be taken to stop this corruption and give relief to the customers?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI SUKH RAM): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Wide publicity is given exhorting customers to desist from giving monetary gratification to the line staff. A full-fledged Vigilance Cell under the charge of General Manager is functioning in the MTNL, Delhi where formal complaint can be lodged by an affected subscriber. Complaint is investigated and strict disciplinary action will be taken against the Deptt. official involved.

Electrification of South-Eastern Railway

1200. SHRI S. AUSTIN: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are considering any proposal for electrification in Muri-Chandil and Purulia-Koteshila section in Adra Division of South Eastern Railway;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the time by which the work is likely to be completed?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI C.K. JAFFER SHARIEF): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The work of electrification of Chandil-Muri-Barkakana section of which Muri-Chandil is a part, is in progress. Purulia-Kotshila is a part of Bokaro Steel City-Muri-Hatia-Kiriburu-Barsuan section, the electrification of which is also in progress.

(c) the electrification of the above sections is likely to be completed by March, 98.
