It may be seen from the above that though the availability during the period April '95-July '95 has increased as compared to the same period last year, the power shortage condition in the state has marginally increased due to growth in demand outstripping the increase in availability.

(c) There is no Central Assistance to Gujarat for increasing the power generation.

(d) In order to bridge the gap between demand and availability of power in Gujarat various measures taken are maximising the generation from the existing generating stations, implementation of Renovation & Modernisation Programme, reduction in Transmission & Distribution losses effective load management and energy conservation measures etc. Assistance is also made available to Gujarat from neighbouring system whenever system condition are conducive to such transfer.

in addition the state also gets its due share from the Central Sector Stations in the Western Region.
