

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI JAGDISH TYTLER): (a) to (c) Central Government allocates the funds to the States as a whole and not National Highway-wise. The amounts allocated for maintenance of National Highways during 1992-93 to 1995-96 in respect of West Bengal are given in the table below. The maintenance figures for 1995-96 do not include the allocations in respect of Special Repairs and Floods Damage Repairs which will be decided towards the end of financial year after assessing the requirements.

Gauge conversion between Tirupati and Katpadi

(a) whether the work on the gauge conversion between Tirupati and Katpadi was started two years ago;

(b) if so, whether the progress of gauge conversion in this section is very slow;

(c) whether the budget allotment made during 1995-96 is only about 6.5 crores;

(d) if so, whether this amount is not sufficient to give priority for the completion of this work; and

(e) if so, whether Government are considering to allocate more funds during 1995-96 so that the conversion work is completed?

(d) and (e) It is proposed to convert Tirupati-Katpadi section to broad gauge with electrification. The work is targetted for completion in 1997-98 to match the gauge conversion of Madurai-Dindigul-villupuram-Madras section, so that people coming from Southern Tamil Nadu to Tirupati on the MG are not put to inconvenience.

As such, the allocation of funds for this project made during 1995-96 is as per the requirements for progressing long lead items and accordingly work on bridges and other long-lead items is being progressed.
