Double line between Gaya and Kharagpur

JAYANTI 1963. SHRIMATI Will the Minister PATNAIK: RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- Government (a) whether proposal to construct a double line between Gava and Kharagpur Tatanagar:
- (b) whether there is also a need to develop and strengthen the existing Railway track between these two places;
- (c) whether the electrification of track on that route is very necessary; and

THE MINISTER OF STATE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SATPAL MAHARAJ): (a) There are two routes to reach Kharagpur via Tatanagar from Gaya, between Gomoh and Chandil. The section Gaya-Gomoh Chandil-Tatanagar-Kharagpur double line. The two routes between Gomoh and Chandil are partially double. Since there are many alternative routes in this area, section capacity is considered adequate for the present.

- (b) The existing track between the above two places is adequate for the level of traffic handled.
- (c) and (d) the route between Gaya and Kharagpur via Tatanagar is already electrified.
