

THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI INDRAJIT GUPTA): (a) The following funds have been released to the Government of Andhra Pradesh under the Scheme for Modernisation of Police Forces:

1995-96	309.560
1996-97	209.560

Apart from above, an additional amount of Rs. 1 crore was released to the Government of Andhra Pradesh during 1995-96.

(b) "Public Order" and "Police" being State subjects, it is for the concerned State Governments to devise various methods and take concrete steps in this regard. At the Central level, action is taken to facilitate coordination of the anti-naxalite operations of different States and to improve flow of information useful for control of naxalite activities among the States. Further, help is being provided to the State Governments in terms of financial assistance for modernisation of police, supply of improved weapons, deployment of paramilitary forces etc.
