

(c) the steps taken to fully assess and explore the deposits?

THE MINISTER OF STEEL AND MINISTER OF MINES (SHRI BIRENDRA PRASAD BAISHYA): (a) Geological Survey of India has established a small gold deposit and located a few gold prospects in Chitradurga district, Karnataka in recent years, but not gold prospect has been found in Sandur district so far by GSI.

(b) The gold deposit has been established in G.R. Halli, South Block. The prospects located in Chitradurga District are Chikkanahali, Gonur Kotomaradi, M.N. Halli, Kunchiganahalu and Honnmaradi. In South Block of G.R. Halli estimated gold ore reserves are of the order of 0.6 million tonnes of 4 gm/tonne. Developmental mining is being carried out by Huti Gold Mines Ltd.

(c) The exploration through drilling and pitting and trenching, geochemical and geophysical methods is continuing to identify the probable reserves and grade of gold ore.

Posts reserved for SC/ST/OBC

(a) whether the reserved posts meant for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other backward communities have been filled up during the last 3 years in the Ministry of Industry;

Revamped Public Distribution System in Manipur
