## Exploration of Mines

3439. SHRI K. M. KHAN: Will the Minister of MINES be pleased to state:

(a) whether some proposal to increase the area for exploration of mines is under active consideration of Govt.;

(b) if so, the details thereof with background;

(c) whether such an activity will bring an estimated increase in export of ores and minerals in future; and

(d) if so, details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STEEL AND MINISTER OF MINES (SHRI BIRENDRA PRASAD BAISHYA): (a) As per the provisions of Section 6 of Mines & Minerals (Regulation & Development) Act, 1957, there is a limit of 25 Sq. K.M. On the area which can be granted for prospecting licence in respect of any mineral or prescribed group of associated minerals. However, the Central Govt, can in the interest of mineral development, permit any person to acquire prospecting licences for areas in excess of this limit. There is no proposal at present to amend this provision of the Act. (b) to (d) Does not arise.
