Electricity generated in the Country

42. SHRI RAMJI LAL: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) the total electricity generated in the country by the existing power projects in comparison with the demand by the public;

(b) the power projects proposed to be undertaken to meet the gap, if any;

(c) whether electricity is also lost in transmission through old apparatus etc.;

(d) if so, the steps taken to provide continuous supply of electricity in the country particularly in Haryana; and

(e) the funds likely to be allocated for this most important sector along with the arrangements for the source, raw material and foreign investments?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF POWER (DR. S. VENUGOPALACHARI): (a) During the year 1995-96, as against the requirement of 389721 million units (MUs) in the country, the availability was 354045 MUs representing a shortfall of 9.2%.

(b) It is proposed to add 2868.5 MW capacity during the year 1996-97.

(c) Some loss of energy is always associated with the transmission of power though any weakness in the system does increase this loss.

(d) Various measures undertaken to improve power supply position in the country, including Haryana, are expediting the commissioning of new generation capacity, implementation of short-gestation projects, improving the performance of existing power stations, reduction in transmission and distribution losses, implementation of better demand side management and energy conservation measures, besides transfer of energy from surplus to deficit areas.

(e) For the year, 1996-97, it is proposed to allocate Rs. 7107.79 Crores for various projects/schemes in the Central Sector including external assistance. Arrangements for fuel supply, domestic as well as foreign, for power projects are also being strengthened.
