India's Strategic Planning to counter Chinese Threat

*19. SHRI RAMDAS AGARWAL: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to a news-item published in the Hindustan Times dated the 31st May, 1996, captioned "India lagging in strategic planning" in defence as compared to China;

(b) whether it is a fact that Pakistan has given to China a solid naval base in Karachi, and Myanmar has permitted use of a naval base in Coco Island to China;

(c) whether the Institutes of Strategic Studies in London and Washington have also voiced concerns over India's poor planning; and

(d) if so, the reaction of Government in this regard, indicating the steps taken to face the threats to the country's security?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI MULAYAM SINGH YADAV): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) There have been media reports from time to time on possible Chinese collaboration with Pakistan and Myanmar regarding acquisition and development of base facilities. Government are aware of extensive cooperation between China and Pakistan and Myanmar in the field of defence. Our concerns in this regard have been brought to China's attention.

(c) Government are not aware of any specific study conducted by these Institutes. In any case, Government do not wish to comment on the perceptions of outside Institutes or on their assumptions and analysis of India's strategic planning.

(d) Developments in neighbouring countries as well as all developments having a bearing on the country's security, are kept under constant review with a view to take appropriate measures to safeguard our national security interests.
