Building of ballistic missile by Pakistan with Chinese help

2. DR. D. VENKATESHWAR RAO: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Jane's, a leading London based international group that monitors defence matters, has reported that Pakistan is building a new ballistic missile at a secret factory with Chinese support;

(b) if so, whether Government have seen the report;

(c) if so, the reactions of Government thereto; and

(d) whether much of the technology of this ballistic missile is said to be based on Chinese M-II medium range missile?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI MULAYAM SINGH YADAV): (a) to (d) Government is aware of the article carried by the foreign Report dated 2nd May, 1996 published, by Jane's Information Group. As mentioned in the article, it is based on unconfirmed report.

A constant watch is maintained on all developments in the region having bearing on India's national security and all necessary measures are taken to maintain appropriate defence preparedness for ensuring security of the nation.

Deployment of M-II Missiles by Pakistan

3. SHRI JANARDHANA POOJARY: Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware that Pakistan has deployed Chinese M-II nuclear missiles;

(b) whether Government have lodged any protest with Pakistan in this regard; if so, the outcome thereof; and

(c) the measures Government have taken to counter this threat?

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI I.K. GUJRAL): (a) Government have seen press reports regarding the deployment of nuclear capable M-II missiles by Pakistan. Government have been aware of the acquisition of these missiles and consider it a matter of great concern.

(b) No, Sir.

(c) Government of India is committed to taking all necessary steps to safeguard its security and national interest in accordance with its own threat perceptions.
