#### Killing of Muslim Worshippers in North Kashmir

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether a number of Muslim worshippers were killed and several others injured at a holy shrine in North Kashmir on the occasion of Id-e-Milad on the 29th July, 1996 when a bomb was hurled at the shrine;

(b) if so, the details of persons apprehended in connection with the bomb attack; and

(c) the action taken by Government in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS (SHRI S. R. BALA-SUBRAMONIYAN): (a) to (c) As per information made available by the State Government, some unidentified militants had lobbed a grenade at the gathering of about 6000-7000 devotees at the Shrine of Hazrat Abu-Baker (RA) at Rawach Dangi-wacha in Baramulla district on 29.7.96 resulting in the killing of 3 persons on the spot and injuring 64 others. A case has been registered. The culprits responsible for the attack have not so far been identified
