VENUGOPALACHARI): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir, the production of non-conventional energy through installation of various systems & devices have been increased. The estimates of energy produced/saved through these sources is given in enclosed statement. (see below)

(c) A wide range of non-conventional energy programmes, such as, National Project on Biogas Development, National Programme on Improved Chulha, Integrated Rural Energy Programme, Solar Thermal Extension Programme, Solar Photovoltaic Demonstration Programme, Solar Photovoltaic Irrigation Pumps, Wind Energy, Small Hydel, Solar Power, Biomass Gasification/Combustion/Cogeneration, etc. have been initiated in the country.

Abandoning the Delayed Projects

3825. DR. B. B. DUTTA: Will the Minister of PLANNING & PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

(a) the number of public sector projects which had time overrun of 60 per cent and incurred only 5 per cent of approved cost;

(b) whether Government propose to abandon these delayed projects;

(c) whether Ministries/Departments have been asked to reprioritise their ongoing projects; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING & PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION

(DR. Y.K. ALAGH): (a) As on 31.3.96 there were 8 projects in the public sector which had time overrun of 60% and incurred only 5% or less of their latest approved cost.

(b) and (c) In February 1996, the Government accepted, in principle, the suggestions of the Group of Ministers on specific measures to cut delays in the implementation of central sector projects. One of the suggestions relates to weeding out/transferring to Joint/Private sector of the projects which are making slow progress in various sectors. Broad features of the proposal are that the projects which would be considered for weeding out/transfer are those on which expenditure incurred is 5% or less even after 60% of the gestation is over. List of projects would be drawn up keeping in view the resource crunch and other relevant factors such as the strategic importance of the project, constraints in land acquisition, change in government policies/market conditions, backward and forward linkage, etc. Ministries/Department have been asked to reprioritise their ongoing projects in the light of the decision of the Government.

(d) No project has been identified under Govt. decision of February, 1996, as yet.
