MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (SHRI YOGINDER K. ALAGH):
(a) yes, Sir.

(b) Science & Technology based programmes being implemented by voluntary Organisations are aimed at promoting research, development and adaptation of technology which may benefit the rural poor; employment generation and entrepreneurship development; and science popularisation.

(c) A number of Voluntary Organisations are active in Madhya Pradesh and they are implementing programmes in areas relating to Science & Technology popularisation; Entrepreneurship, development; Aquaculture; sustainable agriculture; Utilisation of minor forest produce; Land and water management; Bamboo cultivation and value added product-making; Artisanal leather; Rural pottery; Electronics; computer technology etc. It is difficult to precise the exact number of such organisations working in this area because of availability of funds for these programmes from various sectoral agencies and also their own focus shifting from time to time.

Additional Houses under IAY for Flood cyclone victims of Andhra Pradesh

(a) the number of pending requests of Andhra Pradesh Government for sanction of additional 53,880 houses under Indira Awas Yojana for rehabilitation of flood/ cyclone affected victims of that State; and

released in this regard, to assist the State Government to rehabilitate the victims? THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL AREAS & EMPLOYMENT (SHRI CHAN-PRADEO PRASAD VARMA): (a) the Andhra Pradesh Government has requested for construction of additional 40,000 houses during 1995-96 and 13,880 houses during 1996-97 under Indira Awas Yojana to rehabilitate flood-cyclone affected people of the State.

(b) Rs. 40 crores was sanctioned to the Government of Andhra Pradesh during 1995-96 for construction of additional 40,000 houses. The proposal for sanction of additional 13,880 houses is under consideration of the Government.
