Opening of Schools in Kamataka

713. SHRI JANARDHANA POOJARY : Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government propose to open more Navodaya Vidyalayas as well as Kendriya Vidyalayas in Kamataka during the current year; and

(b) if so, the names of the places where these are proposed to be opened?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPTT. OF EDUCATION IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI MUHI RAM SAIKIA) : (a) No, Sir. (b) Does not arise.

Shrimp Farming

714. MISS SAROJ KHAPARDE: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have conducted any survey about the brackish water area available for developing shrimp farming in the coastal areas of Maharashtra;

(b) if so, what are the details thereof;

(c) whether the entire area in the State is being fully utilised for shrimp farming; and

(d) if not, what steps Government propose to take for the full utilisation and development of shrimp farming in the coastal areas of Maharashtra?

THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI CHATURANAN MISHRA): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. Macro level surveys have indicated potential of over 10,000 ha. of brackishwater area suitable for developing shrimp farming; in the coastal areas of Maharashtra.

(c) and (d) About 2000 ha. has been brought under shrimp farming in the coastal areas of Maharashtra. Shrimp farming is taken up in the private sector by farmers for whom the following assistance has been made available:

i) establishment of Brackishwater Fish Farmers Development Agencies in the District: of Thane, Raigad, Ratnagiri, Sindhudurg which provide a package of technical, financial and extension support to shrimp farmers.

ii) provision of incentives in the form of: subsidy for development of shrimp farms, both for extensive and semi-intensive culture shrimp/prawn hatcheries for supply of seed establishment of shrimp feed mills, training of shrimp farmers and establishment of demonstration-cum-training centres, etc.

iii) land lease policy for leasing Government brackishwater land to private entrepreneurs to take up prawn farming activities.

Implementation of Operation Flood Programme

715. SHRI JAYANTI PATNAIK: Will the Minister of ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING be pleased to state:

(a) the names of States where Operation Flood Programme is being implemented;

(b) whether Government have made any review of the implementation of the Programme in those States; and

(c) if so, the details of achievements made as on date under the Programme in the country, Statewise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE DEPARTMENT of ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING (DR. RAGHUVANSH PRASAD SINGH): (a) to (c) Operation Flood Programme has come to a close on 31-12-95, but reimbursements from World Bank for the expenditure committed upto 31-12-95 were available upto 30-4-96. The implementation of programme was being

reviewed periodically. A statement of achievements of the key components of the programme upto 31-3-96. Statewise, is given in Annexure. [See Appendix 178, Annexure No. 22]
