मानव संसाधन विकास मंत्रालय के शिक्षा विभाग में राज्य मंत्री (श्री मुद्दी राम सैकिया): (क) अखिल भारतीय तकनीकी शिक्षा परिषद ने निम्नलिखित दिमी पाठ्यक्रम शुरू करने के लिए ख-वित्त पोषित आधार पर प्राच्य विज्ञन तथा प्रौद्योगिकी संस्थान (ओरिएएटल इस्टीट्यूट आफ साईस एण्ड टैकोलॉजी) सांची की स्थापनार्थ विचार पारती शिक्षा सोसायटी को स्थीकृति प्रदान की। इन पाठ्यक्रमों में सत्र 1994-95 के लिए प्रत्येक के सामने उल्लिखित वार्षिक प्रवेश-श्रमता दर्शाई गई है:—

मैकेनिकल इंजीनियरिग—60 इलेक्ट्रीकल इंजीनियरिग—60 इलेक्ट्रानिक्स इंजीनियरिग—40 कम्प्यूटर विज्ञन तथा इंजीनियरिग—40

(ख) राज्य सरकार की सिफारिशों पर अखिल मारतीय तकनीकी शिक्षा परिषद् ने दो वर्षों की अवधि के लिए अर्थात् 1995-96 तथा 1996-97 सत्र के लिए मोपाल में अस्थायी तौर पर संस्थान संचालित करने की सोसायटी को अनुमति प्रदान की। सोसायटी/संस्था को यह स्पष्ट तौर पर बता दिया गया था कि संस्थान को शैक्षिक वर्ष 1997-98 से सांची में कार्य अवश्य ही सुक कर देना चाहिए और भोपाल में संस्थान को जारी

रखने के लिए और समय नहीं दिया जाएगा। यह भी स्पष्ट किया जा चुका है कि जब तक संस्थान सांची से अपना कार्य शुरू नहीं कर देता 1997-98 के लिए प्रवेश नहीं दिया जाना चाहिए।

(ग) इस संस्थान को संचालनार्थ कोई अनुदान महीं दिया गया है तथापि, अखिल भारतीय तकनीकी शिक्षा परिषद् ने वर्ष 1995-96 के लिए सेमिनार अनुदान येजना के अंतर्गत 35,000/- रुपये की ग्रेशि संस्थीकृत की है।

जहां तक निजी क्षेत्र के अंतर्गत संस्थाओं को अनुमति प्रदान करने का संबंध है, यह राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति और अखिल भारतीय तकनीकी शिक्षा परिषद के अनुरूप है कि निर्धारित शर्ते पूरी करने की शर्त पर तकनीकी शिक्षा के क्षेत्र में निजी सहभागिता की अनुमति प्रदान की जानी. चाहिए।
