Exploration of Gold by MNCs

2161. SHRI KRISHNA KUMAR BIRLA: Will the Minister of MINES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government propose to allow multinationals to explore and mine gold and other precious metals in Karnataka;
 - (b) if so, the facts and details thereof;
- (c) whether the task of exploring gold and other precious metals have ever been assigned to private sector/multinationals in the country; and

(d) if so, the reasons for allowing multinationals to explore gold and precious metals in Karnataka?

THE MINISTER OF STEEL AND MINISTER OF MINES (SHRI BRIENDRA PRASAD BAISHYA): (a) to (d) The National Mineral Policy, 1993 encourages foreign investment and technology in the exploration of high value and scarce minerals. The Policy also dereserves minerals earlier reserved for exclusive exploitation by the private sector, so allowing exploration and exploitation of all minerals including gold, by the

private sector, both domestic and foreign. Any company registered in India can apply to the State Governments for grant of prospecting licence/mining lease.

Growth rate in the value of production in small scale and cottage sector

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI MURASOLI MARAN): (a) The estimated annual rate of growth in the value of production in the small scale sector, at All India Level, for the year 1994-95 was 10.1% and for the first 9 months of 1995-96 it was 10.3%. The growth rate for the first three months of current financial year i.e. 1996-97 is not available.

Similarly annual rate of growth of production in the Cottage Industries (KVI) Sector for the years 1994-95 and 1995-96 was 12.1% and 23.3% (estimated) respectively.
