- 4. Invitation to distinguished professional men and women of Indian origin settled abroad, for short term technical assignments to assist in frontier and emerging areas of science and technology.
- 5. Special recruitment procedures such as a Quick Hire Scientist Fellow Scheme in the CSIR System.
- 6. There is a scheme called Transfer of Knowledge Through Expatriate Nationals under Government of India-UNDP Umbrella Programme, which seeks to utilize the expertise of the NRI Scientists. This scheme has benefited the country through visitation of 575 NRI's todate. With a view to giving further fillip to this initiative, a new Programme has been signed by the Government of India and UNDP at an outlay of about 1 million US dollars for a period of three years.
- 7. Senior Scientists of CSIR have been given additionally the responsibility of mecting brilliant Indian scientists working universities/research establishments abroad during visits there with a view to bringing them back for limited or longer periods.
