The equirement of funds for the current year /as projectd by the Ministry of Defence o the Ministry of Finance, to enable a lecision on the actual allocation, keeping i view the overall availability of national esources, national security and the equirements of different sectors.

Modernisation of our Armed Forces is n on-going process which takes into ccount the changing threat scenario, the dvancement of technology, the global nd regional security environment and he availability of resources. A concerted xercise was undertaken this year, as in revious years to determine the priorities f modernisation, and the resources to be llocated in this context.
