

(d) if so, whether any concrete steps in his regard have been worked out?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI J.V.N. SOMU): (a) to (d) The requirement of funds is estimated by the Ministry of Defence, in consultation with the Service Headquarters on the basis of anticipated, obligatory and contractual payments, regular and recurrent expenditure as well as new schemes under the ongoing modernisation programme of the Defence Services. The requirement of funds for the current year /as projected by the Ministry of Defence to the Ministry of Finance, to enable a decision on the actual allocation, keeping in view the overall availability of national resources, national security and the requirements of different sectors.

Modernisation of our Armed Forces is an on-going process which takes into account the changing threat scenario, the advancement of technology, the global and regional security environment and the availability of resources. A concerted exercise was undertaken this year, as in previous years to determine the priorities for modernisation, and the resources to be allocated in this context.

#### **Diversion of National Highway-54**

1662. SHRI KARNENDU BHATTACHARJEE: Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(a) the latest position on the diversion of National Highway-54 at Ramnagar near Silchar Town;

(b) whether the project has been cleared and funds sanctioned;

(c) if so, the details thereof; and

(d) the latest position of the approach road of Katakhal bridge on National highway-54?

THE MINISTER OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI T. G. VENKATRAMAN): (a) to (c) Alignment for diversion is approved. However, the bridge over river Barak at Badrighat on the bypass is under finalisation. During 1996-97 funds have been provided for payment of compensation for land.

(d) The approach road was sanctioned in February, 1996 and the work is in progress. The two Railway overbridges in the approaches are being entrusted to Railways.

#### **New Telephone Exchanges in Karnataka**
