All permanent Unani Physicians working in CGHS, Delhi are associated with various Purchase. Advisory Committees as Technical members by rotation. The names of the present technical members, are indicated in the statement (See below).

- (c) All Unani medicines purchased by CGHS Unani Store Depot are tested by the various Purchase Committee
 - (d) Yes, Sir.
- (e) As there is no laboratory test available for Unani medicines, they are tested only through Organolyptic medhod.
