4653. SHRI GAYA SINGH; Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a new-lengthy passenger platform No. 10 has been constructed recently at New Delhi Railway Station and very important trains are being operated therefrom; and

(b) if so, what are the details of facilities like catering/vending stalls, etc. provided for the passengers?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI C. K. JAFFER SHARIEF): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) One stall with automatic dispensing machine for sale of coffee, three Pepsi Dispensing Machines and a Bookstall, beside vending of items like economy meals, snacks, mineral water etc by waiters.

(c) whether other zonal Railways are losing as compared to SER; if so, what are the reasons therefor and what steps taken by Government to improve their financial position during 1995-96?
