- (b) if so, what are its major recommendations and the action taken or proposed to be taken thereon by the Central Government;
- (c) whether it is a fact that many State Governments are underutilising or misusing the funds for wasteland development allotted by the Central Government every year; and

(d) if so, who actions being taken to make the stateland development programmes sacessefull in the country?

The Thansks of Reference of this Committee art

## Resrs of Reference:

- (i. Evolve a comprehensive strategy an action plan wastelands is reference to a years; comprehensive strategy for the development of non-forest areas with time frame of 10—15
- (ii) Assess the level of financial resources required and suggest the ways 2nd means and suurce of raising them;
- (iii) Indicate the prospective roles of the central and State Governments and their Departments Panchayati Raj Institutions, Voluntary Agencies, the corporate sector and the financial institutions/banks in the development of non forest wastelands:
- (iv) suggest the specific policy initiatives which the Department of Wastgelands Development may take in pursuance of the mandste given to it.
- (v) broadly outline the mechanisms 'through which the NWDB may seek to implement the strategy and action plan proposed for the development of nonforest wastelands.

The Committee is yet to submit its report. However, the department has not received any report from an expert group on wastelands development since its inception in July. 1992.

(c) and (d) Development of wastelands is a difficult & continuous process. Most projects spproved by the National

Wastelands Development Board are to be implemented in periods ranging from three to five years. Sometimes because of non-availability of land or drought conditions funds cannot be utilised in a particular year. In such cases the funds do not lapse but are carried forward for utilization in the next year.

The Board is releasing funds under the Integrated Wastelands Development Project Schemes largely to the District Rural Development. Agencies and not to the State Government. Under the Grantin-Aid Scheme, funds are released to voluntary agencies whereas under the Technology Developments, Extension A Training Scheme, it is released mainly to Agricultural Universities State and Central/State Research Institutions. However, to ensure proper utilisation of funds. The State Governments have been requested to set up a State Level Monitoring & Review committee under the Chairmanship of the Chief secretary/ Secretary (Rural Development) to have an indepth review of progress of the Integrated Wastelands development Project Schemes.
