#### Sixth All India Educational Survey

5670. SHRI K. RAHMAN KHAN: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Sixth All India Educational Survey has been completed; if so, whether the survey details have been published;

(b) who conducted the survey and whether the survey was a sample survey or total survey;

(c) what are the major conclusion of the survey; and

(d) what are the new innovations included, which were not included in the Fifth Survey?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPTT. OF EDUCATION AND DEPTT. OF CULTURE) (KM. SELJA): (a) No, Sir.

(b) The 6th AIES is a joint endeavour of the National Council for Educational Research and Training (NCERT), the National Informatics Centre (NIC) and the State/UT Governments. The data on core variables have been collected on census basis and on issue specific variables on sample basis.

(c) Does not arise in view of (a) above.

(d) The Sixth Survey is different from the Fifth and earlier Surveys with regard to survey methodology. The innovations *inter-alia*, include use of computer systems for processing of data, satellite based communication network of NIC for direct data movement from the districts

to the national level etc.

**Promotion of Primary Teachers in KVS**

**CULTURE) (KM. SELJA):** (a) The posts of Headmasters in Kendriya Vidyalayas are filled up 100% by promotion from Primary Teachers on the basis of Seniority-cum-merit.

(b) and (c) No, Sir. As per the Recruitment Rules prescribed for the post of Post Graduate Teachers in Kendriya Vidyalayas, only Trained Graduate Teachers with prescribed qualifications and experience are eligible to be promoted.

**Schemes for Women in Karnataka**
