(b) The Planning Commission has approved an outlay of Rs. 100 crores for

the project in the VIII plan. The State Government has incurred an expenditure of Rs. 21.46 crores upto 1994-95 and has proposed an outlay of Rs. 2 crores for 1995-96.

(c) 534 individual works have been constructed comprising improvement of canals, canal structures, canal roads and village road bridges connected with drainage development and modernisation of irrigation system.
