In the case of KV JNU the expenditure for maintenance and repairs is borne by the sponsoring agency.

KVs construction works including repairs and maintenance are entrusted to Government agencies viz-C.P.W.D., M.E.S. and Railways etc. and they have the system of carrying out necessary internal inspections of works carried out by them.

In addition, each Vidyalaya also constitutes its own monitoring "committee to supervise the execution of repairs, maintenance. Periodical inspections of schools are also done by KVS officials from time to time.

(b) As of now, the Mahila Samakhya Programme covers 15 districts, of which two are in Andhra Pradesh, four in Gujarat, five in Karnataka and four in Uttar Pradesh. Mahila Samakhya is also a component under the Bihar Education project and covers 7 districts.

(c) During 1993-94 the Programme was extended to one district in Gujarat.
