Irregularities in Kendriya Vidyalaya Roorkee

(b) if so, what is the number of such complaints received by the Ministry by the Commissioner, Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, New Delhi and by the Assistant Commissioner, Dehradun, separately and the details of each of the complaints, separately;

(c) whether parents of some students of the Vidyalaya and some private individuals have also filed criminal complaints against the Principals;

(d) if so, the details of action taken or being taken in the matter and if no action has been/is being taken the reasons therefor;

(e) whether Government would institute impartial enquiry in the matter and transfer the Principal pending the enquiry to ensure its impartiality to give redress to the aggrieved persons; and

(f) if so, by when and if not, the reasons therefor?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND DEPARTMENT OF CULTURE) (KM. SELJA): (a) to (c) Yes, Sir. Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) has informed that certain complaints have been received against the Principal of Kendriya Vidyalaya Roorkee

alleging victimization, un-becoming conduct with the staff and their families non-Payment of labour charges, mal-practices in the conduct of examination, irregularities in purchases etc.

(d) to (f) A detailed preliminary enquiry into the allegation against the Principal has been ordered by the K.V.S. Further action depends on the outcome of the enquiry.
