SELJA): (a) to (c) As per information received from the Na. tional Open School (NOS) 20 academic and 109 non-academic regular employees are working in the NOS as on date. There are three main departments of NOS, i.e., Administration Department. Academic Department and Examination Depart. Seven sections under the Administration Department look after the work relating to establishment, general administration accounts and audit printing. receipt and issue, stores and mailing, etc. Similarly, seven sections under the Examination Department perform functions relating to conduct of examinations. Five sections under the Academic Department perform various academic functions including accreditation of stitutions, preparation of curriculum, development of vocational and life enrichment courses, etc.

The details regarding grants sanctioned by the Department of Education to NOS under Plan and Non-Plan as well as expenditure incurred by NOS during the last three years are given below:—
