

Benefits to employees of KVS in North east region

SHRI ISH DUTT YADAV:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that some Kendriya Vidyalaya in the country have been labelled as located at difficult stations;

(b) if so, what are the details of transfer benefits admissible to different categories of teaching and non-teaching employees of KVS serving at these stations;

(c) whether these benefits are identical with those admissible for different categories of employees of KVS posted in North East Regions; and

(d) if not, the reasons and justifications thereof?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPTT. OF EDUCATION AND DEPTT. OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The employees who are serving in the difficult stations, after completion of three years tenure are eligible to be considered for transfer to choice stations, in addition to other benefits available as per general rules.

(c) No, Sir.

(d) The benefits available to employees of stations declared as difficult by the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, are determined taking into account the nature of problems faced by the employees concerned. In respect of employees posted in North Eastern Region the benefits are extended based on the general instructions issued by the Govt. of India for its employees in North Eastern Region.
