Testing of OSA-AK Missile from Chandipur

SHRI GHULAM NABI AZAD:

Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Russia has test fired their OSA-AK Missile from Chandipur, Orissa;

(b) whether a large number of Russians alongwith the necessary equipments have arrived in Orissa;

(c) whether Government had agreed to provide all the facilities to Russians for the purpose; and

(d) if so, the reasons for permitting Russians to use Indian soil for the purpose?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI KRISHNAM RAJU): (a) No, Sir. However, facilities for test firing of OSA-AK missile, acquired by the Indian Air Force from Russia, were provided to the Air Force.
