Sports Complexes

4111. SHRI RAJUBHAI A. PARMAR: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are considering to set up more sports complexes to encourage sports activities in different parts of the country including Gujarat State;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the steps proposed to be taken by the Government during the next financial year 1995-96?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS) (SHRI MUKUL WASNIK): (a) No Sir. However, under the Department's Scheme of Grants for Creation of Sports Infrastructure, any State Government can send proposals to avail of central assistance for construction of a district level Sports Complex a Sports Project Development Area (SPDA) Centre or a State level Sports Training Complex. This is a continuing scheme and the State Govt. may avail of central assistance for any of the above types of sports complexes.
