National Council for teacher education

4116. SHRI CHIMANBHAI HARIBHAI SHUKLA: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the date on which National Council of Teacher Education was set up and the objectives thereof;

(b) what is the number of elementary and secondary teachers training institutions in the country at present;

(c) the total number of trainees enrolled in teacher training institutions of the country at present;

(d) whether any scheme has been formulated by the council or Government to meet the shortage of teachers training institutions;

(e) if so, the details thereof; and

(f) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPTT. OF EDUCATION AND DEPTT. OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA): (a) The National

Council for Teacher Education is being constituted. The objectives of the Council are planned development and maintenance of standards in the teacher education system.

(b) and (c) As on 30-9-1993 there were 1778 elementary and secondary teachers training institutions. The total number of trainees enrolled in these institutions during 1993-94 was 232013.

(d) to (f) There is no shortage of teacher training institutions in most of the States.

Grant to organisation of All India Character

(a) what types of organisations fall under the category of "organisation of All India Character";

(b) whether the category includes those recognised institutions also which offer the most advanced course in Arabic Language and in which boys/girls from other States also study;

(c) whether an institution for girls also falls under this category; if so, whether such institution has received any grant so far; and

(d) what action has so far been taken in the case of the 'Madarsatul Banat', Mangrawan, Azamgarh, Uttar Pradesh for financial assistance?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPTT. OF EDUCATION AND DEPTT. OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA): (a) and (b) For the purposes of the scheme of financial assistance to the voluntary organisations for Arabic and Persian, the

following criteria define an organisation of All India character:

(i) Organisations having active branches in more than one State.

(ii) Organisations which have got the status of institutes of National Importance.

(iii) Institutes which give admission after having All India Competition.

Admission of boys and girls from other States though necessary may not by itself be adequate for being categorised as an organisation of All India character.

(c) An institution for girls will also need to satisfy the criteria mentioned in part (a) for coming under this category.

(d) No application was received through the State Government of Uttar Pradesh from the Madarsatul Banat, Mangrawan, Azamgarh, Uttar Pradesh for financial assistance.

Drop out in various level of education

4118. SHRI JOYANTA ROY: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the drop out in the primary, Secondary, Higher Secondary and University level education constantly increasing in the country;

(b) if so, the reasons thereof;

(c) the detailed report of the drop out in stage-wise and state-wise; and

(d) whether Government have any comprehensive action plan to meet the situation?

Secondary Stage. These rates have generally been declining.

(b) Does not arise.

(c) Details of drop out in stage-wise and state-wise upto Secondary stage are available in the Annual Report of the Department for the year 1994-95.

(d) The National Policy on Education (NPE), 1986 and Programme of Action, 1992 spell out strategies for reduction of drop outs. The implementation of the strategies at the primary and upper primary stage was reviewed in a recent meeting of the State Education Ministers held on 4th April, 1995.
