**RE. REPORTED STATEMENT  
OF THE PRIME MINISTER  
AT THE ANNUAL MEETING  
OF FICCI.**

**SHRI SANATAN BISI (Orissa):** Madam Deputy Chairman, yesterday *The Times of India* has published a statement of our Prime Minister delivered at the annual meeting of the FICCI. He said, "The future generation will not forgive if limitless foreign investment and foreign technology are entering India in this manner" ... (Interruptions) ...

**SHRI GURUDAS DAS GUPTA (West Bengal):** He has not finished.

**THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN:** Mr. Bisi, have you finished? ... (Interruptions) ...

**SHRI SANATAN BISI:** I have finished ... (Interruptions) ...

**THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN:** Let him finish first.

**SHRI SANATAN BISI:** Madam, our Prime Minister has made a statement at the annual meeting of the FICCI that the future generation will not forgive him for the manner in which the limitless foreign investment and foreign technology are entering into India. The Government should clarify this point.

**THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN:** Let us stick to our. ... (Interruptions) ...

**SHRIMATI KAMLA SINHA:** (Bihar): Madam, what my colleague, Mr. Bisi has said is rather a serious matter. The Government should clarify whether the Prime Minister has really issued such a statement. My colleague has read out his statement from a newspaper. If the

Prime Minister has said such a thing, then, a clarification must come from the Government. The Prime Minister should resign because he has initiated the new economic policy. So, the Government should resign. It is a very serious matter.

**THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN:** Mrs. Kamla Sinha, the Chairman gave his permission to the hon. Member on the special mention, "Reported statement of the Prime Minister at the annual meeting of FICCI." I suppose the annual meeting of the FICCI was not a closed-door meeting. The Prime Minister spoke at a particular forum which has been reported in the Press... (Interruptions)... Let me finish first.
