Loss 0/ Bombay Blast case papers

106. SHRI K. R. MALKANI: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state;

(a) whether Government has seen the Indian Express report of 28.9.1994 that some important Bombay blast case papers have been stolen;

(b) whether responsibility has been fixed for their loss; and

(c) whether any remedial action has been taken in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI RAJESH PILOT): (a) to (c) Government has seen the Press Report. As per information furnished by the CBI, on 21.9.94, the personal brief case of the Addl. Legal Adviser of CBI was stolen from the car being used by the officers in Bombay. The brief case largely contained personal effects of the officer. Some copies of the Bombay blast case papers which had already been supplied to the accused persons facing trial in this case were also in the brief case. No original paper of the case was in the brief case. The loss of copies does not in any way affect the trial of the accused.

स्वैच्छिक हिन्दी संस्थाओं को अनुदान

107. श्री इकबाल सिंह : क्या गृह मंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि :

(क) देश में, विशेषकर आर्माज इलाकों में, हिन्दी भाषा का प्रचार-प्रसार करने तथा इसे सम्पर्क भाषा के रूप में विकसित करने हेतु जो स्वैच्छिक हिन्दी संस्थाएं कार्य कर रही हैं, उनका व्यौरा क्या है ;

(ख) क्या उक्त हिन्दी संस्थाओं को सरकार द्वारा अनुदान दिया जाता है ;

(ग) यदि हां, तो इन संस्थाओं को इस समय कितने प्रतिशत अनुदान प्राप्त हो रहा है ;

(घ) क्या सरकार इन स्वैच्छिक हिन्दी संस्थाओं को शत प्रतिशत अनुदान देने के संबंध में किसी प्रस्ताव पर विचार कर रही है ; और

(ङ) यदि हां, तो इस संबंध में व्यौरा क्या है और यदि नहीं, तो इसके क्या कारण हैं ?

गृह मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (श्री पी० एम० सिंह) : (क) और (ख) देश में हिन्दी भाषा का प्रचार-प्रसार करने में तथा इसे सम्पर्क भाषा के रूप में विकसित करने हेतु कई स्वैच्छिक संस्थाएं कार्यरत हैं। हिन्दीतर राज्यों में हिन्दी के प्रचार-प्रसार के लिए लगभग 225 स्वैच्छिक संस्थाओं को वित्तीय साधन उपलब्ध कराए जाते हैं। स्वैच्छिक संस्थाओं की सूची संलग्न अनुपत्र में है (देखिए परिशिष्ट-172, अनुपत्र सं. 3 और 4) हिन्दीतर राज्यों की लगभग 225 स्वैच्छिक संस्थाओं को वर्ष 1993-94 में 2.82 लाख रुपए इम मद में व्यय किए गए।

(ग) हिन्दीतर राज्यों में कार्यरत संस्थाओं को वास्तविक व्यय अनुमान का 75% अनुदान दिया जा रहा है।

(घ) और (ङ) मानव संसाधन विकास मंत्रालय के अधीन निमित्त हिन्दी शिक्षा समिति में इस विषय पर चर्चा हुई थी। यह विचार किया गया था कि अतिरिक्त आर्थिक संसाधन उपलब्ध न होने पर इस विषय में विचार नहीं किया जा सकता है।

1991 Census

108. SHRI PARMESHWAR KUMAR AGARWALLA: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) what is "the populatio of the country as per 1991 census; the figures State-wise;

(a) what is the percentage of population of Bihar to the tottal population' of India; and

(c) how does it compare with the population of other States from 1947 onwards; the figures in totals as well as percentages?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI P. M. SAYEED): (a) The population of the country and all States/Union Territories as per 1991 Census is given in the Statement-I (See below).

(b) The percentage of population of Bihar to total population of India (including projected population of Jammu & Kashmir where 1991 Census was not

conducted) as per 1991 Census is 10.21.

(c) The first census after the independence of the country was held in 1951. No census was conducted in the year 1947 and as such the population **figure** for the country and States/Union Territories for the year 1947 are not available. The population of India and other States/Union Territories and their percentages to total population of India for the years 1951, 1961, 1971, 1981, and 1991 are given in the Statement— (See below).
