Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the States where plague disease has taken a heavy toll of human lives;
- (b) the number of people who suffered from plague in those States and the num ber of people died;
- (c) tha precautionary measures adopted to check the spread of the disease;
- fd) whether Government are implementing any scheme for the eradication of plague; and
  - (e) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI B. SHAN-KARANAND): (a) and (b) There has been no heavy toll of death cases on

account of plague in any State. A statement (See below) indicating the presumptive of plague cases and deaths according to N.I.C.D., Delhi is enclosed.

- (c) The following measures were taken to check the spread:
  - Sufficient quantities of drugs and insecticides where supplied to the affected areas.
  - Wide publicity was given to create awareness about the disease and the fact that it was preventable and curable.
  - Prophylactic treatment was given to family members and medical personnel.
  - All suspected cases were screened and investigated trjorov^jhiy.
  - Situation was monitored daily by contacting the States. Control Rooms were established and ap propriate directives issued.
  - Surveillance for rat fall cases and house-to-house surveys undertaken.
  - Mass Chemotherapy was taken in all affected villages.
- (d) and (e) Close surveillance and im plementation of precautionary and ' pre ventive measures are continuing. These would further be strengthened. Streng thening of laboratory facilities are also envisaged.
