SHRI GHULAM NABI AZAD: Madam, I introduce the Bill.

SHRI SUBRAMANIAN SWAMY (Uttar Pradesh): Madam, I want to raise a point of order. (Interruptions)

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SHRI ASHIS SEN (West Bengal): I want to raise a very important point. (Interruptions)

SHRI SUBRAMANIAN SWAMY: I want to draw the attention of the House. (Interruptions)

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: If the House agrees, we can take up the Appropriation Bill and the other Bill first. We can take up Special Mentions in the evening. I take it the House agrees. (Interruptions)

SHRI VIZOL (Nagaland): Madam, kindly permit me to make an important point. (Interruptions)

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: I will permit you, Mr. Vizol. After me, you can speak. Now, let me say that we can take up Special Mentions in the evening. Whatever concerns your mind or is agitating your mind we can have now. Let me identify. Let us hear what the hon. Member there wants to say. (Interruptions)

SHRI VIZOL: Madam Deputy Chairman, as the House is aware, since the Winter Session of Parliament began, till today, there has been a lot of violence in the North-Eastern Region, particularly, in Nagaland. (Interruptions)

In Nagaland, there were two major incidents involving the loss of life of 20 Army men including one top-ranking officer a colonel. (Interruption)

THE VICE-CHAIRMAN (Shri V. Narayanasamy): Let him conclude. I will call you. (Interruptions)

THE VICE-CHAIRMAN (Shri V. Narayanasamy) : Let him conclude.

SHRI VIZOL : In these incidents so many lives of Indian soldiers were lost. Nobody bothers about that. Yesterday a friend of mine, Shri Shukla from this side of the House, brought this issue to the notice of this House, but nobody uttered a word. This is the kind of negative attitude towards the people of the North-East States. Endless incidents are taking place. The army has to act under restraint because of the difficult terrain and the demographic factors. People living in these North-East States are suffering miseries which can never be expressed in words, but nobody is uttering a word about these things. I tell you, a day will come and you will not be surprised when the whole North East will be erupt into cataclysmic conflagration and then it will be too late. When a dozen Indian soldiers of the peace Keeping Force were killed in Europe there was so much concern expressed, but the people in this country are not uttering a word when so many of our soldiers are killed in the North-East area. Because of this I gave notice of a Starred Question but it was converted into an Unstarred Question and the reply given also does not contain any substance. What is this ? Where is the Government. (Interruptions.)

THE VICE-CHAIRMAN (SHRI V. Narayanasamy) : Already there are some names before me. I will call one by one. Yes, Mr. Gautam. (Interruptions). I have already identified Mr. Gautam. Yes, Mr. Gautam, be brief.

श्रीमती सत्या बहिन (उत्तर प्रदेश) : महोदय यह बड़ा गंभीर मामला है और हमारे पूर्वोत्तर राज्यों में जिस तरह से आतंकवाद है और उससे हमारे कर्मियों को जिस तरह ज़ुलम पड़ रहा है उसकी तरफ सरकार को ध्यान देना चाहिए। (व्यवधान) मैं यह कहना चाहती हूँ कि पिछले दिनों कर्नाटक में बहुत आतंकवाद था लेकिन जब से वहाँ पर लोकप्रिय सरकार आई है आतंकवाद में कमी

आई है मगर इधर देखते हैं धाया है कि फिर कुछ बढ़ाएँ हो रही हैं। इस और सरकार को ध्यान देना चाहिए। (व्यवधान)

RE. QUESTION OF PRIVILEGE

श्री भानुब प्रकाश गौतम (उत्तर प्रदेश) : महोदय पिछले सत्र में 23 अगस्त को मैंने इस राज्यसभा में अनुसूचित जाति और जनजाति के आरक्षण कोटा को पूरा करने के संबंध में एक विशेष उल्लेख किया था। उस विशेष उल्लेख के दौरान मैंने एक ऐसे शासकीय पत्र का जिक्र किया था जो कामिक विभाग की ओर से सभी विभागों को जारी किया गया था और उसमें यह लिखा गया था कि 50 प्रतिशत आरक्षण ही भरा जाएगा और 50 प्रतिशत नहीं भरा जाएगा। इस संदर्भ में मैंने उस शासकीय पत्र का उल्लेख किया था। माननीय मारशेट भ्रत्वा जी उस समय यहाँ भीजूद थीं। उन्होंने इंटरवीन किया था और उसके बारे में सचना दी थी। उसे सदन के सामने रखते हुए मैं उस मामले में विशेषाधिकार के हनन का प्रस्ताव प्रस्तुत करना चाहता हूँ। मानेजय गंगा जी ने कहा था कि—

“I would just like to point out that there was a recent judgment of the Supreme Court when the entire question of reservations had come up. They have said that reservations shall not exceed fifty per cent. In view of that, a circular had been issued. But I would like to clarify that since then, the issue was raised in the other House; a meeting of all the leaders was called by the Speaker in which Minister for Social Welfare and other officials were called and the matter was sorted. And it had been decided that a fresh circular would be issued. The whole matter has been sorted out amicably after the issue was raised in the other House and discussed. Also, the necessary instructions are being issued. They have already been issued.”
