Finalisation of Balance sheet to nationalised Banks

925. SHRI RAJNI RANJAN SAHU : Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether balance sheet for the year ending 1993-94 in respect of all nationalised and other banks have been finalised;

(b) if not, how many and which banks have not finalised the balance sheet and reasons therefor; and

(c) whether Banks which were found involved in the security scam, have accounted for the unreconciled scam amount in their balance sheet of 1993-94?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI M.V. CHANDRASHEKARA MURTHY): (a) and (b) Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has reported that except Punjab National Bank, Benares State Bank Ltd. and Kashi Nath Seth Bank Ltd., all other nationalised banks and banks in the private and foreign sectors have finalised their balance sheets for the year ended 31st March, 1994. While finalisation of the balance sheet of Punjab National Bank is held up pending a decision

on the capital restructure arising out of deficit of erstwhile New Bank of India as on 4-9-93, the balance sheets of Benares State Bank Ltd. and Kashi Nath Seth Bank Ltd. have not been finalised by their statutory auditors.

(c) The banks have reported that their balance sheets have been prepared in accordance with the approved guidelines for the year and certified by the respective auditors.
