implementation (c) For effective of JRY in the country, including the backward areas, the quantitative and qualitative implementation is moni-At the Central regularly. of level, the implementation is reviewed through monthy, quarannual progress reports, terly and received from the State Governments, Bosides Officers at the Centre, ,State Headquarters and districts, sub-divicions and block levels closely monitor all aspects of the programmes. through visits to worksites . State Co-ordination Committee (SLCC) for rural development procrammes also monitors the progress of implementation of JRY alongwith other schemes.

The Government of India also periodically review the programmes with the State Government officers with a view to effecting improvement in the quality of implementation.

Recently, the Ministry has also introduced the Area Officers Scheme in which Teams have been formed of the senior officers of the Ministry of Rural Development, Ministry of Programme Implementation and the Planning Commission. Each Team has been allocated one or two States where they visit regularly and give feed back on implementation of rural development programmes.
