- (b) what are the details of Recruitment Rules for filling up of the vacancies of Teachers in Navodayi Vidyalaya;
- (c) whether G «ernment propose to amend those Rules; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and by when amendments are proposed to be made?

OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA): (a) According to information furnished by Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti, the vacancy position of teachers in the Navodaya Vidyalayas as on 30th June '94 is given in the enclosed Statement-I (See below). Vacancies have primarily been due to nonavailability of suitable SCs/STs candidates to (ill up the reserved vacancies and nonavailability of eligible Trained Graduate Teachers with 5 years service for promotion.
