Achievements upto 1993-94 under the scheme are given in the Annual Administrative Report for 1993-94 of the Department of Education.

The scheme of non-formal education has also been recently revised and strengthened.

The National Policy of Education (NPE) 1986, provides that non-governmental and voluntary effort will be encouraged subject to proper management.
