1992 में शिक्षा प्रबंधन पर राष्ट्रीय परिप्रेक्ष्य को बढ़ावा देने की दिशा में एक आवश्यक कदम के रूप में धारतीय शिक्षा सेवा (आई० ई० एस०) की स्थापना का प्रावधान किया गया है। इसमें यह भी प्रावधान किया गया है कि इस सेवा के बुनियादी सिद्धांतों, कार्यों और भर्ती की प्रक्रियाओं के संबंध में राज्य सरकारों के परामर्श से निर्णय निया जाना चाहिए। तदनुसार राज्यों से भारतीय शिक्षा सेवा के गठन पर अपनी विस्तृत टिप्पणियाँ भेजने का बनुरोध किया गया है। अब तक केवल गोवा, कर्नाटक, मध्य प्रदेश, पंजाब और पांडिचेरी एवं लक्षद्वीप संध केव प्रशासनों से ही टिप्पणियाँ प्राप्त हुई हैं।

Preservation of Shakespearian Literature

- (a) whether it is a fact that valuable volume of Shakespeare is now in possession of the National Museum which was earlier in the possession of Military Library, Roorkee University, Roorkee during the period of East India Company in the country;
- (b) whether this valuable book which is now in a brittle condition requires an expenditure of six to seven lacs as estimated by the department concerned after consultation with a UNESCO advisor sometime in 1953;
- (c) whether this precious book is proposed to be auctioned by the Roorkee University to meet their financial difficulties; and
- (d) if so, what steps are proposed to be taken by Government for the preservation of the precious volume of Shakespear which is the only Shakes-pearian literature available in the country?
