(e) what is the justification, if any in each of such instances?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPTT. OF EDUCATION AND DEPTT. OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA) : (a) Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan has intimated that in 1994, 127 TGTs on promotion as PGTs have been posted in the same places against available vacancies.

(b) and (c) One TGT on promotion as PGT (Phy.) has been adjusted against the post of Vice-Principal at Kendriya Vidyalaya No. 2, Delhi Cantt. This was done in view of the need of posting of the Chief Executive of a recognised service association at its Headquarter.

(b) when the sub-committee was set up and when did it submit its report;

(c) when the recommendations were approved; and

(d) when the recommendations were accepted?

and (u) Internal Financial Adviser.

(b) The sub-committee was set up on 16-2-1984 and submitted its report on 8-3-1984.

(c) and (d) The recommendations were accepted on 7th April, 1984.

C.G.H.S. Facilities to the Employees of KVS

2844. SHRI JALALUDIN ANSARI : Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE

DEVELOPMENT be pleased to refer to the answer to Unstarred Question 3401 given in the Rajya Sabha on 18th March, 1994 and state :

(a) whether Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan has since received any clearance from Director-General, Central Government Health Scheme, for extension of CGHS facilities to its employees; and

(b) if so, the details thereof; and if not, the reasons therefor and the number of times CGHS has been reminded to expedite the decision during the period?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPTT. OF EDUCATION AND DEPTT. OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA) : (a) and (b) Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan has informed that it had approached the C.G.H.S. Authorities for extending the benefits of CGHS Scheme to all the employees of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan wherever, CGHS facilities are available. The C.G.H.S. Authorities have informed that they are not in a position to extend the facilities to new categories of beneficiaries.

Eradication of Illiteracy in Madhya Pradesh

2845. SHRI SURESH PACHOURI: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state :

(a) whether Government have formulated any special schemes for eradication of illiteracy in Madhya Pradesh particularly amongst the Tribals of the State;

(b) if so, what are the details thereof;

(c) whether any targets have been fixed for this purpose for the next three years;

(d) if so, what are the details thereof; and

(e) what concerted efforts are being made by Government to eradicate illiteracy in the State?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPTT. OF EDUCATION AND DEPTT. OF CULTURE) (KUMARI SELJA) : (a) to (e) No special scheme as such has been formulated for eradication of illiteracy in Madhya Pradesh. However, Universalisation of Elementary Education, Non-formal Education for School drop-outs and Adult Education Programmes under the National Literacy Mission constitute the strategy for eradication of illiteracy. Under the National Literacy Mission, so far 29 Literacy Projects have been sanctioned covering fully 23 District and 6 Districts partly. In addition, 7 Post Literacy Projects have also been sanctioned.
