- (c) Government of Gujarat has agreed to provide incentives for the said project. However, final decision regarding financial assistance has not yet been taken.
- (d) The project is likely to start in early 1994 and the production is likely to commence in the latter half of 1995
- (e) The production is likely to be between 10,000 to 15,000 nos. per annum initially.

Joint ventures between Israel and Guiarat

- (c) if so, what is the reaction of the Central Government in this regard;
- (d) what are the details of total number of investment plans cleared by the Centre in respect of Guiarat:
- (e) whether Gujarat is the only State which has taken highest lead in foreign investment proposals; and
- (f) if so, what are the total proposals that are agreed and are under implementation?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (DEPTT. OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT) AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (DEPARTMENT OF HEAVY INDUSTRY) (SMT. KRISHNA SAHI): (a) Government are not aware of any such statement.

- (b) and (c) In view of reply to part (a), question does not arise.
- (d) to (f) Foreign collaboration approvals are intended only to determine the terms and conditions of collaboration and therefore, these approvals do not usually indicate location of the industries. Consequently, state-wise break-up of these approvals are not centrally maintained.
