(d) As per 8th plan objective the waiting period for telephone connection is to be reduced to two years in large telephone systems, and telephone practically on demand in rural and tribal areas by the end of 8th Plan (1992-97) and exchanges are planned accordingly to meet this objective. In Bangalore about 28000 lines switching capacity in targeted for 93-94 and about 90000 lines planned for 94-95. In Hubli about 3600 lines switching capacity is targeted for 93-94.

Exchanges in the State of Harvana particularly in Narwana (District Jind) telephone Exchange:

- (b) whether it is also a fact that the equipment of the mechanical Exchanges has failed to provide efficient services to the public:
- (i) whether the government pose to consider the replacement all the Exchanges of Haryana by Electronic equipment If so, by what time it is likely to be replaced.
- (d) whether Government propose to fulfill its promise to replace equipment of Marwana Exchange; and
- (e) by what time it will start functioring?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OFTHE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICA-TIONS (SHRI SUKH RAM): (a) Yes, Sir, he complaints of No-dial Tone/Held up etc: are received from time to time.

- (b) The services and facilities electro-mechanical exchanges are not comparable with that of electronic exchanges as expected by the subscribers. In case of Narwana, 600 lines MAX II (US type) was installed in 1988 and expanded in steps to 1200 lines in 1990-91. The performance of this exchange is quite satisfactory.
- (c) At present, it is not possible to replace all the Electro-Mechanical exchanges by electronic equipments due to constraints of funds. However, life expired and worn out electro-mechnical exchanges which is 20 years in this case are replaced on availability of required equipments.
- (d) and (e) At present, it may not be possible to replace Narwana MAX-II (U/S type), However, C-DOT type 424 lines electronic exchanges is proposed to be introduced during 93-94 in addition to MAX-II exchange to cater to new demands.

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICA-TIONS (SHRI SUKH RAM): (a) Yes. Sir. Government propose to provide telephone in all 6745 (and not 6500) villages of Haryana State.

- (b) and (c) (i) As a first steps, the Governmeth have adopted a policy to cover all the Panchayat Villages with telephone facility Progressively 31st March, 1995 subject to availability of resources.
- (ii) As on 30th November. 1993. out of a total of 5792 Panchavat Villages in Harvana, 4172 such villages have been covered with telephone facility.
- (iii) Provision of telephone facility in non-panchayat villages has been period April, proposed during the 1995 to March, 2000.
