Immediately, the University reported the matter to the local The University has taken action for safe custody and strict accounting of blank identity cards It has also constituted a Preliminary Fact Finding Committee to look into all aspects of matter.

The University has also taken further proctorial measures to stop entry of unwanted persons in the campus which include rigorous checks at the gates other sensitive points of the camples; surprise checks during late evening and night hours and maintenance of security system in the adjoining colleges.

Welfare Plan for Destitute Children in Delhi

A City Task Force has been constituted by the Govennment of National Capital Territory of Delhi under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to look after the welfare of street children in Delhi by establishing effective linkages with the existing infrastructural facilities. The Central Scheme for the Welfare of Street Children je also being implemented in Delhi and under that scheme six voluntary organisations have been entrusted with the task of implementation of the aforesaid scheme. One more voluntary organisation is vet to be selected by the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi. Under this scheme, the children will be provided (i) Non-formal education, (ii) health care, (iii) vocational training, (iv) nutrition, (v) shelter and (vi) recreation.
