1356. SHRI DILIP SINGH JUDEV : Will the Minister of PLANNING AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether a sub-committee of the National Development Council (Lanthan Wala Committee) has suggested that an educational cess be levied on the urban and rural sources of revenue and various incomes and properties;

(b) if so, whether the universities are likely to overcome their financial crisis as a result thereof:

(c) whether any, decision has been taken on the recommendation of the Committee by Government;

(d) if so, the details thereof; and-

(e) if not, the reasons therefor ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING AND PRO-GRAMME IMPLEMENTATION (SHRI GIRIDHAR GOMANGU1 : (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The terms of reference of the Committee do not include issues pertaining to University/Higher Education and are confined to the field of literacy.

(c) to (e) The Report was placed before the National Development Council and the Council inter-alia had considersd the report. Endorsing the recommendations of the Literacy Report, the National Developmnet Council Committee directed that a meeting of Chief Ministers should be convened for further discussions and to work out an Action Plan for effective implementation of the recommendations.

Meeting of the National Development Council

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING AND PRO-GRAMME IMPLEMENTATION (SHRI GIRIDHAR GOMANGO): (a) Yes, Sir. The Forty Sixth Meeting of the National Development Council was held in New Delhi on 18th September, 1993 under the Chairmanship of the Prime Minister.

(b) The Reports of four NDC sub-Committees on Employment, Population, Literacy and Micro-level Planning and Involvement of People at Grass-root Level and also a paper on "Education for all" were discussed in the The NDC meeting. endorsed the recommendations of its above mentioned sub-Committees, and directed the nodal ministries viz. Human Resource Development for Literacy and Education for all, Health & Family Welfare for Population and Planning Commission for Micro-level Planning and Employment generation 10 initiate further action.

Demand of Funds for Gujarat Electricity Board

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF PLANNING AND PRO-GRAMME IMPLEMENTATION (SHRI GIRIDHAR GOMANGO) : (a) The Central Government has been normally providing block Plan assistance to the State for their Plans according to formula approved by National Development Council. Central assistance has not been allocated specifically to Gujarat State Electricity Board.

(b) There is only one on-going hydro electric project in the State of Gujarat namely Kadana Stage II (2x 60 MW). The approved outlay for this project for the year 1993-94 is Rs. 40 crores. The approved Power Sector outlay for Gujarat for 1993-94 is Rs. 466.40 crores, 1994-95 proposals are yet to be finalised.
